



American States Water Company Announces Regular Common Dividends and Notice of Third Quarter Results Conference Call

SAN DIMAS, Calif.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Nov. 8, 2005--The Board of Directors of American States Water Company (NYSE:AWR) approved a quarterly dividend of \$0.225 per share on the Common Shares of the Company. This action marks the 278th consecutive dividend payment by the Company. For more than 50 consecutive years, American States Water Company shareholders have received an aggregate annual increase in their dividends.

Dividends on the Common Shares will be payable on December 1, 2005 to shareholders of record at the close of business on November 18, 2005.

American States Water Company will release its third quarter results on Wednesday, November 9, 2005, followed by a conference call at 11:00 a.m. Pacific Time (PT), during which management will be making a brief presentation focusing on the Company's results, strategies, and operating trends.

American States Water Company is the parent of Golden State Water Company, American States Utility Services, Inc. and Chaparral City Water Company. Through its subsidiaries, AWR provides water service to 1 out of 30 Californians located within 75 communities throughout 10 counties in Northern, Coastal and Southern California (approximately 252,800 customers) and to approximately 13,000 customers in the city of Fountain Hills, Arizona, and portions of Scottsdale, Arizona. The Company also distributes electricity to approximately 23,000 customers in the Big Bear recreational area of California. Through its non-regulated subsidiary, American States Utility Services, the Company contracts with various municipalities, the U.S. government and private entities to provide various services, including billing and meter reading, water marketing and operation and maintenance of water and wastewater systems.
